- ◆ 1 Time Airlines has been given the rights to operate a 5-weekly service between Johannesburg and Maputo. They also launched their flights from Johannesburg to Livingstone on 26 November 2009.
- ◆ SA Express is urging passengers to get tickets on the George route issued at least 24 hours after confirmation, due to the high demand for this route.
- ◆ Cathay Pacific now offers passengers the option to secure seats with extra leg room in economy class, by paying an additional US\$100 per sector.

- ◆ From 20 November to 12 December, Cape Town is playing host to a number of events around the final draw for the FIFA 2010 World Cup, on 4 December. As a result, certain areas will be affected and travellers are asked to plan ahead as accommodation and car rental is already limited.
- ◆ Thandiwe January-Maclean, former South African ambassador to Portugal, has been appointed as the new Chief Executive of SA Tourism.
- ◆ The Central Terminal Building (CTB) at Cape Town International Airport has opened, and all airlines have moved their check-in desks to the new facility. The 5-storey CTB has 120 check-in desks and 20 self-service kiosks in its domestic and international departures halls
