- ❖ A certificate of incorporation of the company in Nigeria
 - ❖ A business letter from the South African company stating that they will be covering all costs while in Nigeria or provide proof of funds required
 - ❖ Form CAC2 for non-Resident Director of Companies in Nigeria
 - ❖ Proof of Hotel reservation if not invited by a company
